THERE IS ONE GOD

In the Old Testament there are many good lesson for us to learn. In 2 Kings we read about a king who was a good king but found himself in somewhat of a problem. "And Hezekiah prayed before the Lord, and said, O Lord God of Israel, which dwellest between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: thou hast made heaven and earth" (2 Kings 19:15).

The Assyrians were a mighty people and there was the threat of war against Israel. They actually had surrounded the walls of Jerusalem and were demanding surrender.

The Israelites were greatly outnumbered and it seemed either to surrender or die. But Hezekiah knew one other thing and that was to pray to the one true living God which he did.

Rabshakeh had made the brag that there was none of the gods of these other nations that were able to save the Israelites from destruction. Of course all other gods are just made up of natural things. Psalm 96:5 says: "For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the

Lord made the heavens."

Hezekiah knew the true and living God and prayed to Him fervently believing that God would deliver His people from evil.

It was in that very night that God sent just one mighty angel in answer to Hezekiah's prayer, and destroyed 185 thousand of the Assyrians army.

So when the true and living God is involved great things take place.

Today, the God of heaven and earth is still on His throne and continues to answer our prayers, when we call on His name through Jesus our High Priest.
