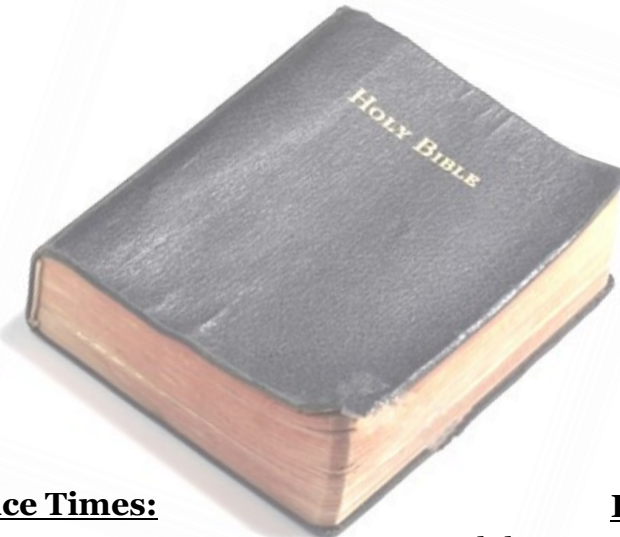

DIFFERENT LEADERS

"When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn" (Proverbs 29:2).

What is true in the past can be considered true in our day as well.

Israel wanted a king, even though the Lord God Himself was their true king and could bless them in a positive way. And the Lord said unto Samuel, *"Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them"* (1 Samuel 8:7).
