<u>"A DISCIPLE IS NOT ABOVE HIS TEACHER, NOR A SLAVE ABOVE HIS MASTER"</u>

(Matthew10:24) N.A.S.U.

Two things to notice in this verse. One is the word "disciple" and the other is "slave".

Then you have two other words of importance "teacher" and "master".

In this verse you have a two-fold relationship of the Christian to the Lord. We are disciples and slaves or servants. He is our Master and Lord.

We understand that the word for disciple if one who is a follower of Jesus. He would be considered a pupil one who would be taught by the teacher.

Our teacher is the Lord Jesus Christ who teaches us through His word. That word has been delivered to us by the Holy Spirit, who inspired the writers of the New Testament.

The purpose is to give us the directions we need to be pleasing in the eyes of God. As Christians we are under the authority of our Lord and no Christian has the right to question or oppose or reject the teaching of our Lord.

When we consider the word "slave", a slave has no rights, for he is under the owner.

We are bought with a price and therefore we are owned by our Lord, and under is direction. He is the supreme ruler of those in His kingdom. If we reject the Lord we will suffer the consequence of doing so.

It is so important that we do not reject His words; but obey every command that He has given by His Word.

The world may scoff, but it is terrible when Christians scoff at the word of God ,and turn aside from it and go astray.

Jesus prayed that we all be one and we cannot be one if we are turning aside from His teaching. Let be true to His words. RH
