THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

Luke 4:1-13

Life always exists and revolves around a certain center. The very heart and core of the Christian life is Jesus, God's Son.

Therefore, the Christian life is more than just believing and being baptized and having your name appear in a "church directory". The Christian life is a "Life of Faith."

"And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God" (Luke 4:4).

Here we have the magic word of the Bible. *"Faith"*. Paul tells us how it is obtained in Romans 10:17.

There is power in the word. "For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12).

The Christian life is also a Life not of this world. To many professed

disciples find themselves not only in this world, but also of this world. (James 4:4).

The Christian must realize some things! He or she is in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3). They have been born of incorruptible seed (1 Peter 1:23). They are not of this world (Romans 12:2). And that Christ has the living bread (John 6:51-58).
