WORSHIP

Worship is a most important part of the Christians life. We come to worship God not to be entertained.

We come with the intent and purpose to do so in an effort to please God and give Him the glory that He so much deserves.

In the five acts of worship each has a special significance. Let's take a look at each one of these acts.

SINGING: Question, Is it important to sing? Someone might say well I just cannot sing well. God did not tell us to sing well, what he did tell us to do is sing. Ephesians 5:19

Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

Notice in this verse he said sing and make melody in your heart. He did not say just think about it but he said we are to sing.

When we do we are teaching others. If we don't sing then we fail to glorify God and we also fail to teach and encourage others. It is not how you might sound that is important but that you are opening your mouth and saying the words of the song and thinking about those words.

PRAYER: It is a means of communication with God. As a matter of fact it is the only means at our disposal to talk to God.

I would hope that you pray at home and maybe many other places as you

have the opportunity. But, at worship there usually is someone leading us in prayer.

When we are being lead, we should be following along with the prayer and it should be our prayer as well.

LORD'S SUPPER: This act is the one that is to be done only on the first day of the week.

There are some who say you can do it anytime but according to the Bible the disciples met on the first day of the week to partake of the Lord's Supper.

It is a time for us to reflect on the death and shedding of his blood for the remission of our sins.

The bread and fruit of the vine are symbolic of the body and blood of Christ. Our minds needs to be focused on that great sacrifice Jesus made for us.

GIVING: As we can read the disciples came together on first day of the week and they gave a contribution to the work of the church (1 Corinthians 16:2).

They were to purpose in their heart what they were going to give (2 Corinthians 9:7). Giving is an expression of our appreciation for how God has blessed us in life and it demonstrates our love to the Lord.

PREACHING/TEACHING: This also is an important part of our worship. To hear a message from God's word to learn, to encourage, and build up our faith, and to prick our hearts to obey the Lord.
