THE WORD AND THE CHRISTIAN

I want to base this on an Old Testament passage.

Psalm 19:7-9 *“The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. 8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.”*

I would say that many Christians spend little time in the word of God.

Peter said we need: *“The sincere mild of the word”* (1 Peter 2:2). In order to have a healthy joy and a spirit filled life.

Of course that is not enough for we must also have the strong meat of the word of God as well in order to grow and become strong in our faith.

The word of God should be like what the Psalms said In (119:103) *“Thy words”* are also *“honey to*

my mouth.”

Not only is the word of God for salvation; but also so that we can be sanctified and cleans day by day as we live for the Lord.

It is the word that will guide us each day. (Psalm 119:105).

Beside that a daily study of the word of God enables us to put on the whole armor of God to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Only if we will use it to gain strength in the Lord. David's statement in Old Testament reminds us of Paul statement to Timothy in 2 Timothy. 3:16: *“Every scripture inspired of God is also profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for instruction which is in righteousness.”*
