Dear brother and sisters in Christ,

This first year as director of Amerindian Missions has been quite enlightening and a great blessing. I agreed to take on this work somewhat blindly but with a commitment to restore, maintain and grow the work that our dear brother Jerry started out of his love for lost souls.

I have enclosed a financial statement for the year 2020.

I greatly appreciate each of you and your continued support of Amerindian Missions. I'm especially grateful for the extra funds you've given to help with the Covid-19 Pandemic Relief to our hurting brethren in Guyana. We've now completed the work. We've exceeded our original goals thanks to your help. We've now delivered over 11 tons of staple food supplies to 21 villages, helping over 2,400 people. Our brother Sunil Joseph and his family have worked very hard to accomplish this great work.

The brethren in Guyana have expressed their gratitude for your kindness. I've enclosed a summary of this relief effort and I hope you can publicize it and give our thanks to the congregation. We could not have done this without your help.

We are now supporting 18 brethren in Guyana who are working in the kingdom under some very difficult situations. For the first time ever we've given each preacher a \$25 USD per month raise. Those of you that support a specific preacher, if you would consider increasing your contribution by that amount, it would be a great help to us. The total monthly outlay is about \$5,200 USD. I do not take any income from Amerindian Missions for myself, so nearly all that is given goes directly to the work in Guyana.


We have received information indicating that we can now fly again, with some restrictions, so I'm making plans to go teach in the school in March.
