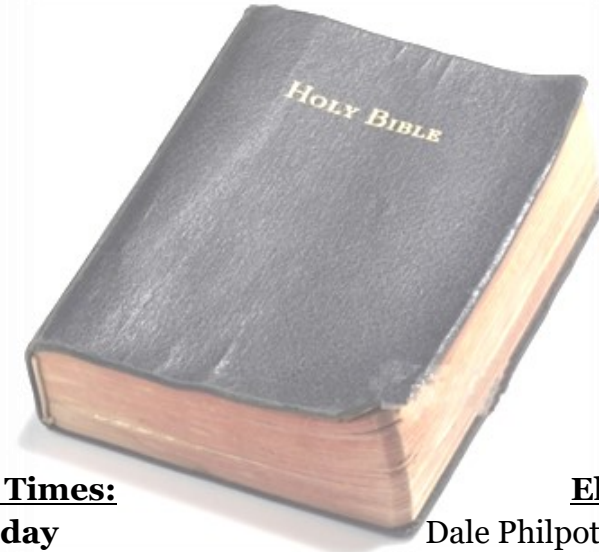

OUR SYMPATHY

To Pippenger family at the passing of Neal Pippenger, last week in Benton, TN. Neal was uncle of Keith Pippenger.

THE CREATOR

Colossians 1:16-17, *For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist*”.

In Matthew 8:17 we read about how large waves cover a ship on a small lake in a short time could only have been generated by a powerful wind and it was creating a complex problem for the disciples of Jesus who were in the boat.

Even if the winds dies down the waves would continue for a time. But suddenly both cease at once, and *“there was a great calm”* (v. 26). There was no known natural force to produce such a phenomenon, yet there it was.

Jesus had simply spoken the word: *“Peace be still”* (Mark 4:39). How could this happen, how could He control the sea? The reason is the sea is His, he made it.

“The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry

land.” (Psalm 95:5).
What about the stormy wind?
“He causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings for the rain; he bringeth the wind out of his treasuries” (Psalm 135:7).

God can use the storms of life to cause us to call on Him for deliverance. *“For He commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof....Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and He bringeth them out of their distress. He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still”* (Psalm 107:25,28,29).

What manner of man can do such a thing? Only the God/Man, Jesus Christ. He is the omnipotent, living word, the *“Creator of the ends of the earth”* (Isaiah 40:28).

If this eternal word (who was “made flesh” and was now sleeping in a small boat in the Sea of Galilee) could speak the mighty cosmos into being, it is not great thing for Him to speak peace to a stormy sea or to bring rest to His loved ones in their times of turmoil and fear. Do you believe this?
