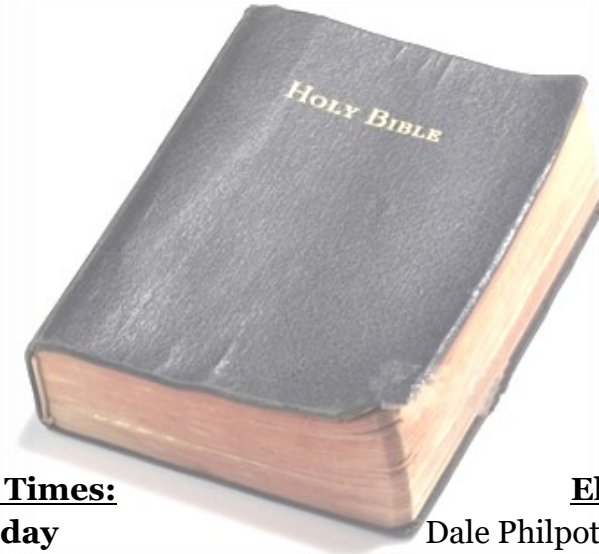

## THE WORD AND THE CHRISTIAN

I want to base this on an Old Testament passage.

Psalm 19:7-9 *“The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. 8*

*The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.”*

I would say that many Christians spend little in the word of God. Peter said we need: *“The sincere milk of the word”* (1 Peter 2:2) in order to have a healthy joy and a spirit filled life.

Of course, that is not enough for we must also have the strong meat of the word of God as well in order to grow and become strong in our faith.

The word of God should be like what the Psalms said In (119:103) *“Thy words”* are also *“honey to my mouth.”*

Not only is the word of God for salvation, but also, so that we can be sanctified and cleans day by day as we live for the Lord. It is the word that will guide us each day. (Psalm 119:105).

Beside that a daily study of the word of God enables us to *“put on the whole armor of God to stand against the wiles of the devil.”* (Ephesians 6:10-17).

This is the only way we can have victory over the sins of the world; if only we will use it to gain strength in the Lord.

David’s statement in Old Testament reminds us of Paul statement to Timothy in 2 Tim. 3:16.
