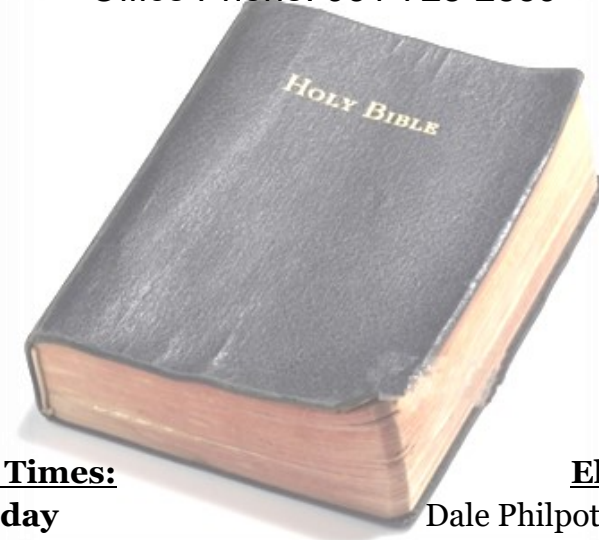

HE THAT BELIEVES WILL HAVE JOY

I think of the passage that Peter wrote which says this:

"Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory." (1 Peter 1:8).

If you remember after Jesus resurrection He acknowledged that legitimate need for evidence of such a mighty miracle.

He honored the request of Thomas to see for himself that He indeed had returned from the grave.

Even though Thomas should have believed the evidence from what the other disciples when they said we have seen the Lord.

That is they were testifying that the tomb was empty for we saw Jesus with our own eyes. Of course then Jesus mildly rebuked Thomas for doubting.

Jesus then said to Thomas. *"Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed."* (John 20:29)

Not only did Thomas see Him after he came forth from the grave. But Paul say this in 1 Corinthians.

"And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: 6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

7 After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles. 8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time" (1 Corinthians 15:5-8).

We have not seen Jesus as the other disciples, and as Thomas did, but we believe because of the eye witnesses that did see Him after He came forth from the grave on the third day.

Our hope of forgiveness and eternal life in heaven comes as a result of Jesus being raised from the dead. Paul says this: *"And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins"* (1 Corinthians 15:17).

But we do believe and we do rejoice in Christ.
