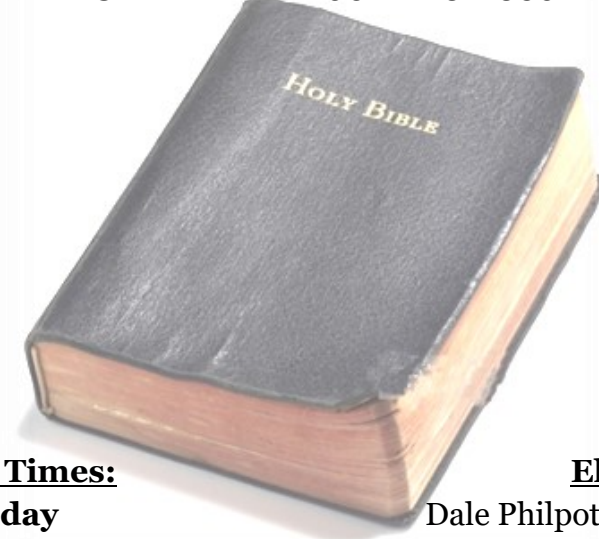

## A SURE SALVATION

I read this story that told of Queen Victoria of UK, who was deeply moved during a church service. Afterward, she asked her chaplain, “Can one be absolutely sure in this life of eternal safety?”

He did not have an answer. But an evangelist named John Townsend heard about the Queen’s question, and after much prayer he sent her a note.

“With trembling hands, but heartfelt love, and because I know that we can be absolutely sure now of our eternal life in the Home that Jesus went to prepare, may I ask your Most Gracious Majesty to read the following passages of Scripture: John 3:16; Romans 10:9-10?”

He is not the only one who has used these two passages to the exclusion of other that are so vital to one have the assurance of knowing that they have eternal life.

Nothing wrong with those two passages but, they are not enough to convince me that

they alone are enough to give confidence and assurance of life eternal. You know so many times, John 3:16 is quoted and they say see he that believeth in him should not perish. And they are saying that that scripture alone is all one needs.

But, if you were to understand the idea of believeth in the passage, one would understand that it carries with it the idea of obedience.

Here is what the ASV says: “*He that believeth on the Son hath eternal life; but he that obeyeth not the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abideth on him:* (John 3:33).

Here you have somewhat of a commentary on John 3:16.

So there is more involved than just believe and confess. One also must repent and be baptized. (Acts 2:38).

And one must be faithful till death in order to have assurance and confidence of eternal life with God in heaven.
