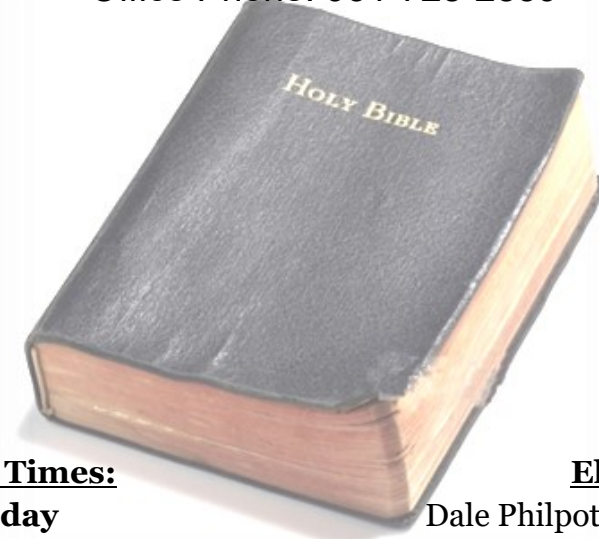

## THE WRATH OF GOD

In today's society we hear much of the love of God. Everybody is saying God is love and that it true, but you don't hear much about the wrath of God.

You see there is the love of God and there is the wrath of God. Yes God's love is demonstrated in the giving of His Son on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins.

But, let us think of the other side of God and that is God's wrath.

In Romans 11:22 Paul writes by inspiration, and says this. *"Behold then the goodness and severity of God; toward them that fell, severity; but toward thee, God's goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off."*

A chapter later, Romans 12:19 we find, *"Avenge not yourselves, beloved, but give place unto the wrath of God: for it is written, Vengeance belongeth unto me; I will recompense, saith the Lord."*

In the book of Hebrews you have these words.

*"For we know him that said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense. And again, the Lord shall judge his people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God."*

This is not talking about falling into the hands of a loving God, but a God of wrath.

Of course God has provided a way to avoid His wrath. Peter said: *"The Lord is not slack concerning his promises, as some count slackness; but is long-suffering to youward, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."* (2 Peter 3:9).

God's great love and mercy have been manifest in giving man an opportunity to escape the just desserts of his sin and be able to not experience the wrath of God.

Only through obedience to the gospel and faithfulness can we escape that wrath.

IF we are WILLING to ACCEPT HIM and be OBEDIENT to the gospel of Christ.
