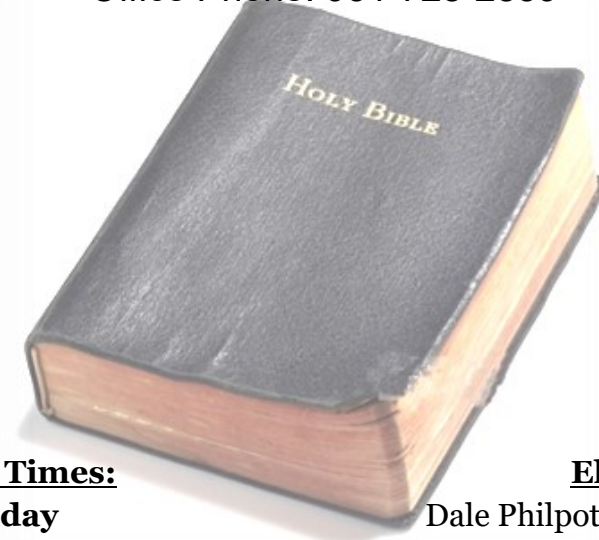

## SINGING IN THE NIGHT

Acts 16:25

I believe we can say that the results of Paul and Silas singing at midnight was because of their faith and devotion to the Lord.

From the Bible we can see that this has been the thing that godly men have done through the ages.

*“O my God, my soul is cast down within me: therefore will I remember thee from the land of Jordan, and of the Hermonites, from the hill Mizar.*

*7 Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me.*

*8 Yet the Lord will command his lovingkindness in the daytime, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life” (Psalm 42:6-8).*

Again, *“I call to remembrance my song in the night: I commune with mine own heart: and my spirit made diligent*

*search” (Psalm 77:6).*

*“Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds” (Psalm 149:5).*

Even though we might find ourselves in the darkest part of a dungeon, shut off from the outside world, and having been beaten, and put in chains, and deprived of sleep.

Can we imitate the behavior of Paul; instead of murmuring and complaining, can we sing, and praise God for his great love and care?

The spirit that can sing in the night is the spirit which can rejoice and praise God under all kinds of situations even when it is unfavorable.

It will always be the case that God’s grace is sufficient to sustain us in difficult times. And we can be merry even in troublesome times.

James said: *“Is any among you afflicted? Let him pray. Is any merry? Let him sing psalms” (James 5:13).*
