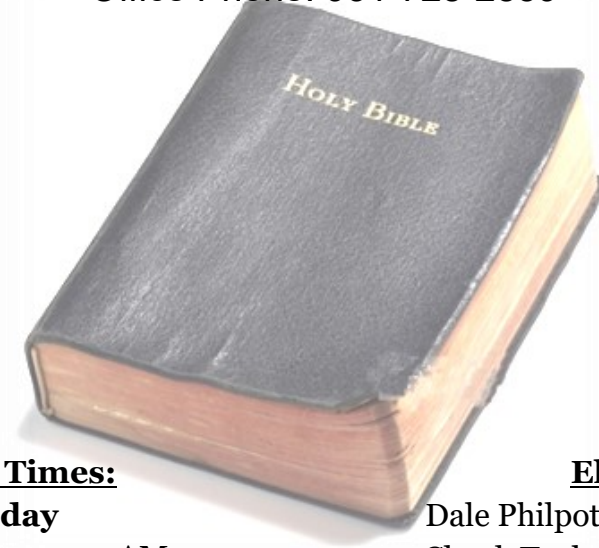

OUR FATHER IS RICH

When God created the world, he put a wealth of riches in the land. Many people search for those riches and some find treasures of gold and diamonds.

Our heavenly Father is rich! There is an old hymn, “A Child of the King,” which reminds us of who we are as royal children.

The first verse sets a stage by reminding us of just who the King our Father, really is. He is rich!

“My Father is rich in houses and lands, He holdeth the wealth of the world in His hands! Of rubies and diamonds, of silver and gold, His coffers are full, He has riches untold.”

The book of Psalms says this about our Father.

“For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills. 11 I know all the fowls of the mountains: and the wild beasts of the field are mine. 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof (Psalms 50:10-12).

As men search of gold and precious stones, God says this: *“My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver” (Proverbs 8:19).*

Now stop and think about this. Our Heavenly Father’s riches are far greater than natural riches *“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us” (Ephesians 2:4).*

“O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!” (Romans 11:33).

Paul said in Philippians: *“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:19).*

But then notice what Paul says again about our Lord.

“For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich” (2 Corinthians 8:9).

Again: *“And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory” (Romans 9:23).*

So as a child of the King we have unimaginable wealth. We have heaven and all the riches and happiness that is there.
