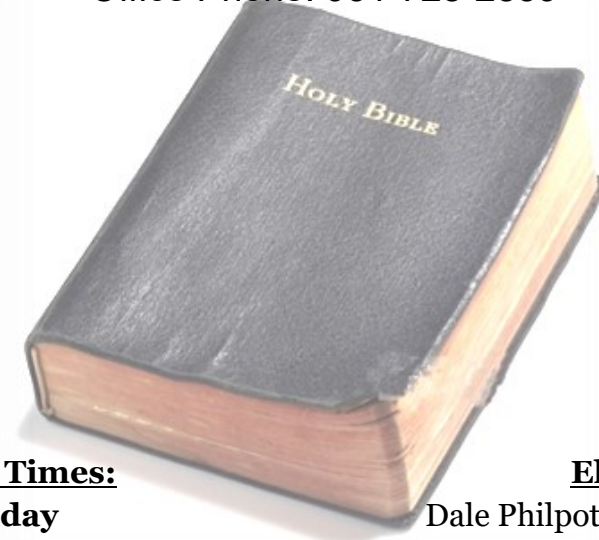

BEING ABANDONED

Isaiah 49:15-16 *“Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee. 16 Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of my hands; thy walls are continually before me.”*

I read about two men who went to the Smithsonian Air and Space Museum in Washington, DC and noticed a baby stroller nearby by itself, but upon looking inside there was a baby.

Where was the parents they wondered and after a time they approached a museum official who they took the baby to a safe place. Here the baby was in a sense abandoned. Have you ever thought about what it would feel like to be abandoned?

That would be an overwhelming feeling; that no one cares anything about you. It would have to be a real and excruciatingly painful feeling.

Even if people abandon us there is one who will never abandon us, and of course that is God. His love and presence is assured to all that follow Him.

The Lord promises that He will

never leave us (Deuteronomy 31:8). Also in Hebrews: *“Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee”* (Hebrews 13:5).

He will be with us wherever we go, *“always, even to the end of the age”* (Matthew 28:20).

The Lord will never falter in His commitment to His children. Nothing can separate us from His love (Romans 8:35-39). We must trust Him!
