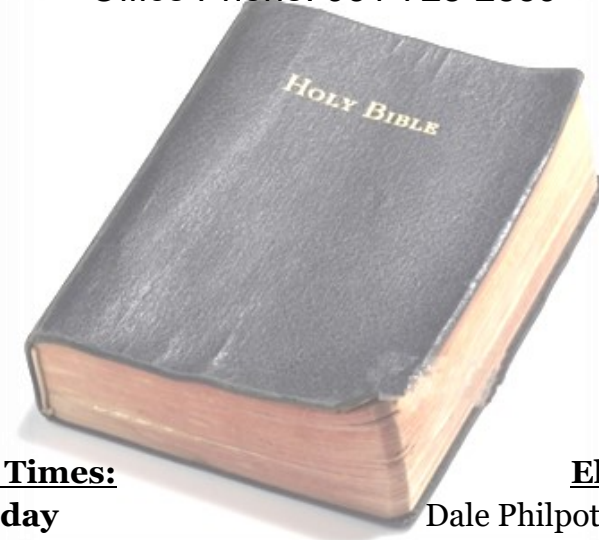

## THE LAMB OF GOD

JOHN 1:29

There were two occasions where John called Jesus the Lamb of God. One is in John 1:24-29, when John was speaking to the Pharisees.

The other is a little later in John 1:36 just after Jesus was baptized to fulfill all righteousness.

This is one who stood among them whom they knew not (v.26). This term "ye know not" refers not to experiential knowledge, but intuitive recognition.

They were of course looking for a prophet, or a king who would be able to liberate them for the Roman yoke.

The Pharisees would think that slavery was really a worse calamity while in reality it was slavery to sin, that they were in. They had no sense of sin.

Remember they were a self-righteous group and it seems that they had no idea that they were in slavery to their

own sins.

When we think about the Lamb of God becoming flesh and dwelling among us, there is a reason for that. He became a man so that he would be that sacrificial lamb.

The Jews wanted a liberator to free them from Roman rule but, what they really needed was to be liberated from sin. Jesus came for that purpose.

You remember John said the "*Lamb of God which taketh away the sin of the world*" (v.29).

This is not the first time Jesus was mentioned in Scripture as the Lamb. Isaiah said: "*He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth*" (Isaiah 53:7).

Jesus became the promised lamb of the Old Testament to shed His blood for the world.

Peter said: "*But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:*" (1 Peter 1:19).

The Hebrew writer said "*without shedding of blood there is no remission*" (Hebrews 9:22).

Christ the Lamb of God shed His blood for **ALL** who will obey.
