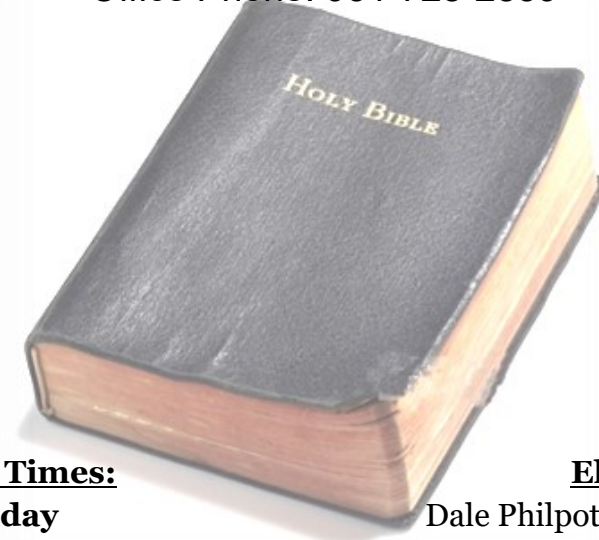

BE STILL AND KNOW THAT HE IS GOD

Psalm 46:10

Back in the book of Ruth, Ruth was told by Naomi: "Then said she, Sit still, my daughter, until thou know how the matter will fall: for the man will not be in rest, until he have finished the thing this day" (Ruth 3:18).

This was instruction to Ruth in hopes that her kinsman, Boaz, would be willing to perform his family duty and marry Ruth, whose husband had died in Moab.

Everything Ruth did was honorable, and she had done all she could to let Boaz know she was willing to be his wife. Now all she could do was to sit still and wait.

There is a lesson here for all of us who are Christians. All too often we want to rush ahead of God, fearful that things won't work out unless we take matters into our own hands.

When the Jews were invaded by the As-

syrian armies and they felt helpless in vain and to no purpose they felt they needed an alliance with Pharaoh.

God warned: "*For the Egyptians shall help in vain, and to no purpose: therefore have I cried concerning this, Their strength is to sit still. 15 For thus saith the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not*" (Isaiah 30:7,15).

Many years before that when Israel was coming out of Egyptian bondage and were in desperate situation with the Egyptian armies pursuing them and Red Sea in front of them.

"And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will shew to you today: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen today, ye shall see them again no more forever" (Exodus 14:13).

Sometime we need to wait. Boaz finally married Ruth.

Six hundred years later the host of the Assyrians were slain by the angel of the Lord.

There is, certainly, a time to work and work hard in the service of the Lord.

But there is also a time when we need to be still and know that He is God.
