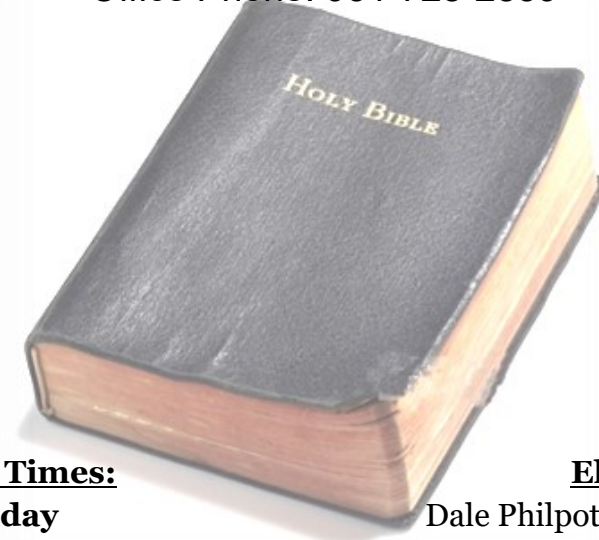

**SOME POINTS ABOUT JESUS**  
**ARREST IN THE GARDEN**

John 18:1-11

In these few verses there is some qualities concerning Jesus.

It shows **His courage** when they came out to get Him. Perhaps they thought they would have to search for Him.

When they arrived Jesus asked, "Who are you looking for?" Jesus of Nazareth, they said. He answered: "I am He." Here is the courage of Jesus knowing why they came for Him.

It shows **His authority**. Here is one man unarmed, yet there are many who come for him. Yet, in face of Him, they step back and fall to the ground.

They must have noticed the power that radiated from Jesus. There flowed from Him an authority that made Him stronger than the ene-

mies. It also shows that Jesus chose to die. He could have chosen to escape but he stood and was arrested.

It shows **His love** for the others. It was not for Himself that he took thought but, those who were his friends.

He said I am the one you want, so let these go their way. He thought more of them than he did of him self. Jesus said: "*Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends*" (John 15:13).

It shows **His utter obedience**.

He said "*shall I not drink the cup the Father hath given me*". He knew this was God's will and for Him that was enough.

He was Himself faithful unto death. Even though Peter was going to defend Him. "*Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword*"

"*Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels? But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?*" (Matt 26:52-54).
