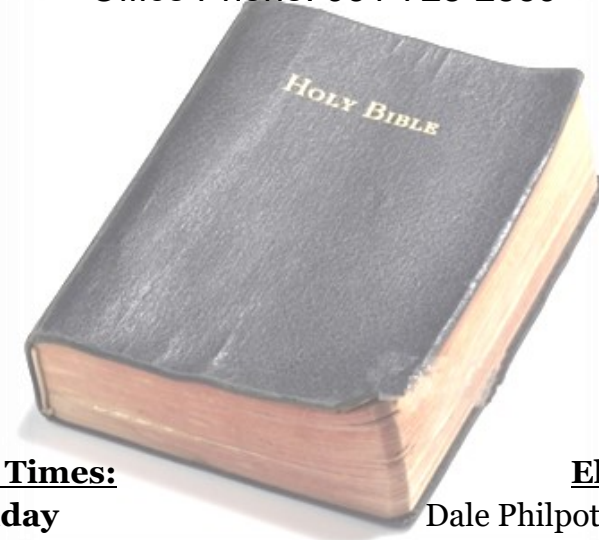

CLEAN UP YOUR LIFE

2 CORINTHIANS 7:1

Paul begins by saying because of these promises, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit.

This first part is on the negative side. We might say there are two kinds of cleansing. One is positional and the other is practical. The first one is a cleansing that only God can do through the sacrifice of Jesus and His shed blood.

We recognize our sins and therefore come in obedience to the gospel plan in order to be cleansed.

The other cleansing, the practical one is where we are obligated, charged to do. It is the cleansing of our actions, our deeds and our words.

Paul said in the book of Colossians:

"Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornica-

tion, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry" (Colossians 3:5).

Then later he gave a list of things to put off: *"But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. 9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds"* (Colossians 3:8-9).

You notice it says in our text *"let us cleanse ourselves."* There are things that we are responsible for; put away and stop doing after we become a Christian.

There is the filthiness of the flesh. Any physical practice, habit or indulgence which causes us to become defiled we need to put away. Then he speaks of filthiness of the spirit. This I think, deals with our inside, that which is not exposed, but in the heart.

It could be hatred, malice, jealousy, animosity, ill-temper, pride and many other things. These are some things that we must correct. It is up to us to make the necessary changes. Paul challenges us to cleanse ourselves.
