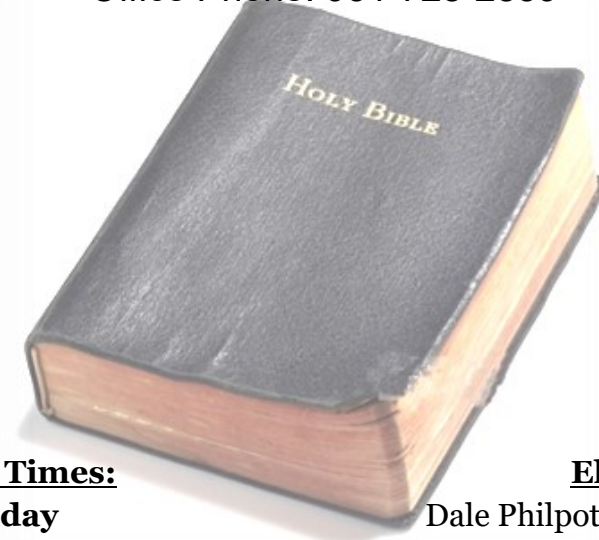

LIVING A HOLY LIFE

2 CORINTHIANS 7:1

In an earlier article from this same verse we talked about cleaning ourselves of the filthiness of the flesh and the spirit.

That was the negative side of this verse.

Now let us look at the positive side: *“Perfecting holiness in the fear of God.”*

So again we find ourselves faced with a responsibility. The charge here is perfecting holiness. Of course when one becomes a Christian through obedience to the gospel of Christ he or she becomes holy, but this holiness must be something that we continue to pursue.

The meaning of holiness according to Strong’s is this *“(physically, pure, morally blameless or religious, ceremonially, consecrated):*

Paul said: *“I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness”* (Romans 6:19).

Then, again Paul said: *“But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.”* (Romans 6:22).

Paul is saying by inspiration, that we have a responsibility to continue in holiness by living the life we have in Christ.

If we live as Christ instructs us, then holiness will grow in the life of a Christian. Holiness comes as a result of our faithfulness and by our reverent respect for God.

Whoever lives reverently before God will find its effect in their lives. The person who respects God is one who has cleansed himself from the filthiness of the flesh and spirit and then is perfecting a holy character.

Take God out of life, then men live to no good and for no purpose. But with respect for God and His word, man will strive to live a holy life.

This is the positive side if the verse. A lot more could be said but space will not allow.
