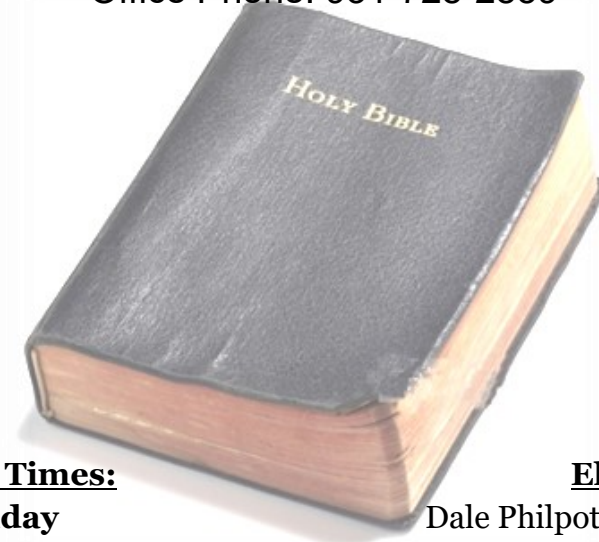

SELF-EXAMINATION

2 Corinthians 13:5

In this verse there are three challenges to them. We will look briefly at each of these.

“Examine yourselves.”

As we very well know there are time that we need to take this to heart and look at ourselves in view of God’s word to see where we stand. It is to see if we have any spiritual disease. Is there something in our lives that is unholy and unhealthy? It is an examination to see if we are growing spiritually and maturing in our faith? It is asking ourselves how I measure up in regards to God’s word. Am I steadfast in the faith?

“Prove your own selves.”

The idea in this phrase means to test. It is not a test of feelings because our feelings fluctuate and vary from time to time. Proving your own selves will also be in view of God’s word. There are several test that we find in the Bible. What about love? “We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death” (1 John 3:14).

Overcoming is another test.

“For whatsoever is born of God

overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith” (1 John 5:4).

Besides these two there are many more. Such as good works, kindness, purity, righteousness, worship, prayer and more. We can ask the question. Am I involved in good works? Am I a person who is kind? Am I a person seeking purity in life? Am I a person who truly worships God and prays regularly?

The Result—*“Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?”*

This is the result of examining ourselves. That we may know ourselves. We want Jesus Christ to be in us so people can see who we are and whom we follow. By self-examination we can know if we are redeemed or reprobate, saved or lost, whether we are true or false.

John said this: “These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God” (1 John 5:13).

The question is, Do you know?
