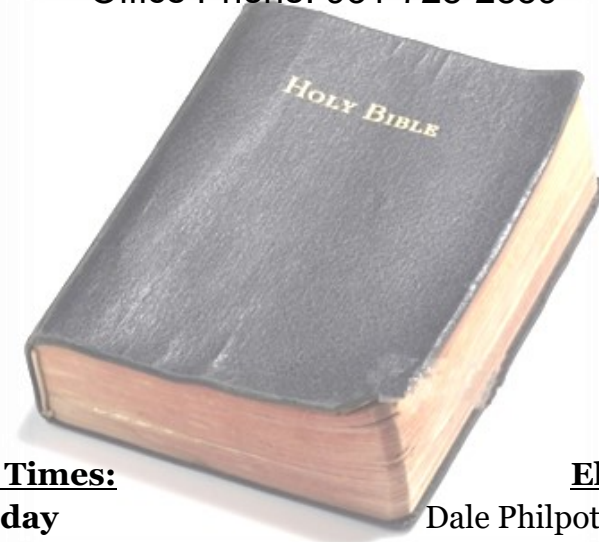

## A NEW LIFE

2 Corinthians 5:17

As I continue with the thought of last week's article concerning a new life, there are two important facts about a Christian.

**First:** He is a New Creation.

This is settled in the words of Paul when he wrote by inspiration, "*If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature.*"

The word creature can be interchangeable with the word creation. Both of the words would be correct. We as Christians have a new creation that is different from the old creation.

We came into being as a result of God creation. God created Adam and Eve and from them sprang a race of people down to the present day, but that race of people became sinners and in need of help that only God could provide.

We, as the Bible says, *were dead in trespasses and sins*, (Ephesian

2:1). We were alive physically but dead spiritually. So I think you can see there was a need for a new creation.

We would call it a new way of life. It is of course the life that we now have through Jesus Christ.

**Second:** One lives in a New Way of Life. Notice what Paul says: "Old things are passed away; behold all things are become new."

There is such a great change that takes place in the Christians life. It comes from the "*new birth of the water and the spirit*" (John 3:5), where we become a new creation in Christ.

This new life we are now to live brings, new habits, appetites, desires, ideals, and many other things. But, it must be nourished in order to grow and develop. Does that mean we will never sin, the answer is **no**. There is forgiveness through prayer.

We strive to make our lives to be an influence to others, and be pleasing to God. This of course is a daily process.

Regardless this new life begins in Christ. So the question is this. Are you in Christ or out of Christ? If in Christ you are a new creature. If out of Christ you are still the old man in sin.
