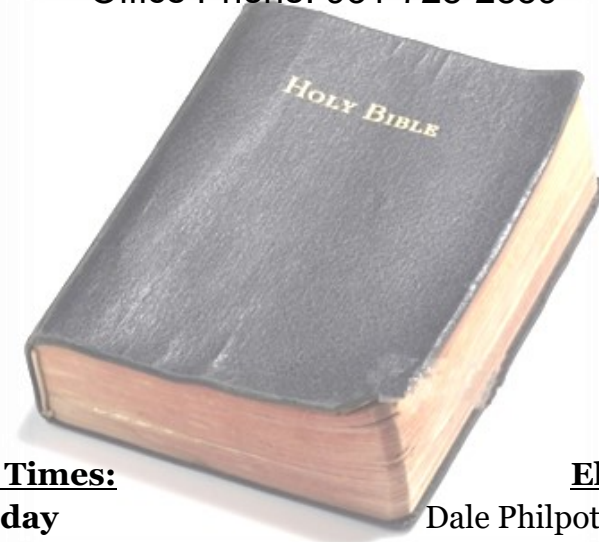

GOD'S WORD OF JUDGMENT

“Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king asked him secretly in his house, and said, Is there any word from the Lord? And Jeremiah said, There is: for, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon” (Jeremiah 37:17).

At the time this was stated, the city of Jerusalem was being surrounded and besieged by the army of the Babylonians.

The prophet Jeremiah was trying to get the people and the rulers to change their ways.

Here he was accused of being on the side of the enemy. So he was arrested and held in a dungeon. Prior to this Jeremiah had preached again and again in the name of the Lord, and had given warning to the king that the policies he was pursuing were dangerous, and wrong, and he needed to change.

But, Zedekiah nor those of his close counselors would listen to what Jeremiah had to say from the Lord.

When the city was threatened and Jeremiah silenced in prison, Zedekiah sent for him secretly and asked this question: *“Is there any word from the Lord?”* **Jeremiah said: “There is...You shall be delivered into the hands of the king of Babylon.”**

That of course is not what Zedekiah wanted to hear. He wanted to hear words of encouragement and assurance that the Lord would protect His chosen people. But that was not the word of the Lord, it was the word of doom and gloom.

Let me say this, as it might apply today. If you are not a Christian then the word of the Lord for you as long as you stay in that condition, is doom and gloom.

There is no hope outside of the Lord Jesus Christ for those who have never obeyed the gospel of Christ.

Is there a word of the Lord for you? Yes there is and it goes like this. *“And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity”* (Matthew 7:23).

You see if you are **not on the Lord's side**, then **you are on the devil's side** and he is doomed, and also those that are with him.

It will not be God's fault but only you to blame.
