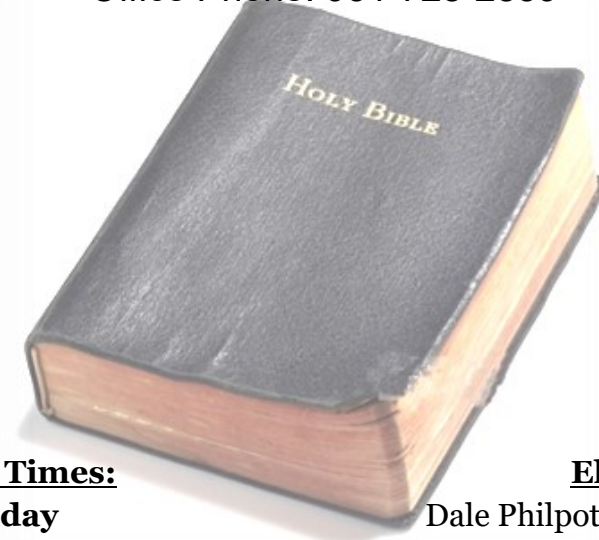

JUDGMENT AND THE END

"For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?" (1 Peter 4:17).

Have you ever really given some thought to this verse? Peter has in his mind in the first letter to seek to encourage Christians to stand firm in the face of persecution and the suffering of trials that come upon them. He seeks about four times to cause them to think about final end.

First he says this: *"Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls"* (1 Peter 1:9). Here he speaks of the final deliverance of the whole person.

Another thing he says is: *"Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ"* (1 Peter 1:13).

As we live; there is the need to be sober, diligent in action aware of the tribulations that come and be prepared to endure them.

Something else is this: *"But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer"* (1 Peter 4:7).

Notice that Peter says the end of all things is at hand. So again our response is to be sober and be watching unto prayer. To be sober is to be of sound judgment, being sure that we make the right decision based on the word of God with eternity in mind.

We have God cleansing as a result of our obedience to the gospel. Therefore we can look forward to the end; here and eternity in heaven.
