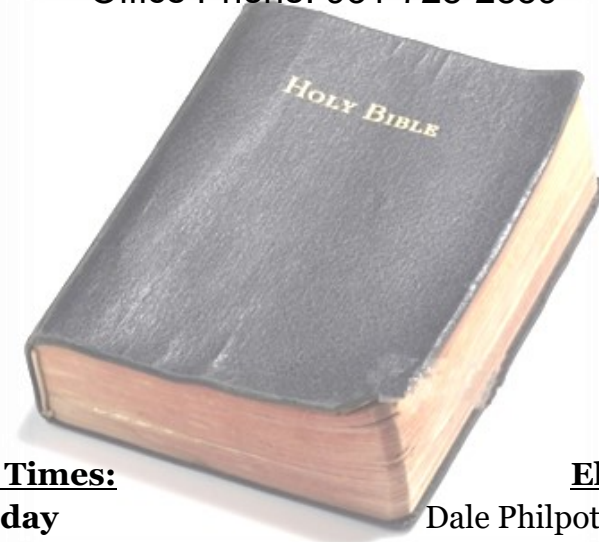

THE BREAD OF LIFE

JOHN 6:51

They said, *“What sign showest Thou then that we may see and believe Thee”* (v, 30). Jesus did many mighty works, but He Himself was the greatest sign of all.

This bread was of Divine Origin. *“I came down from heaven.”* These words occur seven times in this chapter. His home was in heaven, and His coming to earth was a coming down.

So far down that it is not possible for us to measure the local or moral distance. Down from glory to poverty and shame and death.

This bread has Wondrous Character. It is *“Living Bread.”* As the living bread of God He is: Live Giving. *“I am come down that they might have life”* (John 10:10).

This bread makes the dead to live. This life from God was in the bread, His gift to a dying and dead world.

Also, this bread is *“Life Satisfying.”* *“He that eateth this bread*
