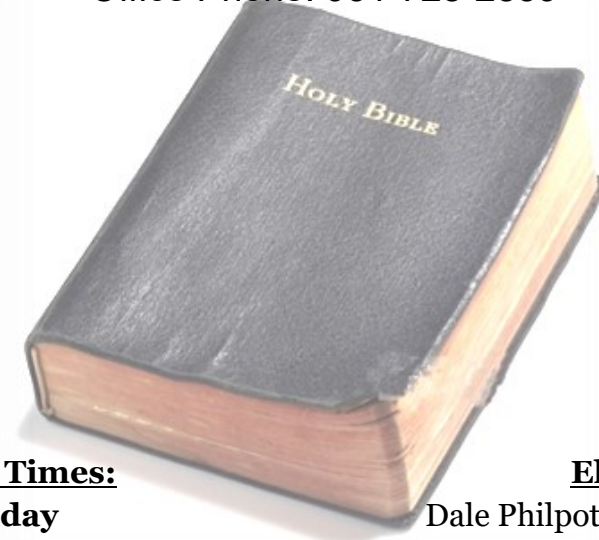

### GODS COMPLAINT

Isaiah 1:3, *“The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib: but Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.”*

Thoughtfulness about the things of the world, and thoughtlessness about the things of eternity, is a very common sin among the people of God.

Superficial thinking leads to superficial living. The ox knoweth his owner, and the donkey his master's crib, but how often the Lord's people fail to recognize their Owner, or the blessings He provides for them.

Inconsiderateness is a great hindrance to the growth of spiritual life and to usefulness because it is dishonoring God. Mere talk and mechanical actions will never be substitute for pure heart reflection. If we would take time to meditate until the fire burns, our lives would not be so powerless and fruitless. “My people doth not consider.” This is the language of wounded love.

Think on some of those things which we fail to consider as we ought, and of which God might justly complain, “My people doth not consider.”
