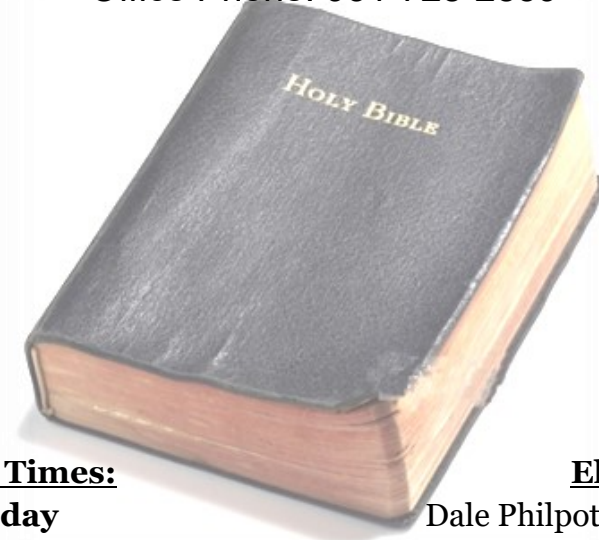

THE BLESSED HOPE

TITUS 2:13-14

This blessed hope is characterized as—

A good hope: “Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace”

(2 Thessalonians 2:16).

A sure hope: “That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have

fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us” (Hebrews 6:18).

A living hope: “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead” (1 Peter 1:3).

A saving hope: “For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?” (Romans 8:24).

A purifying hope:

“And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure” (1 John 3:3).

A comforting hope: “Wherefore comfort one another with these words” (1 Thessalonians 4:8).

It is the **blessed hope** of every individual that has obeyed the gospel, and is continuing to be faithful in the Lord. This person has the desire and the confident expectation of heaven.
