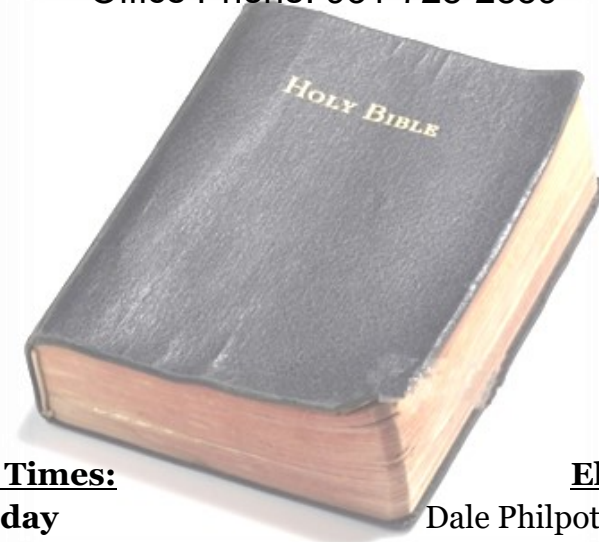

### MARVELOUS SAVIOR

*“But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men, And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross” (Philippians 2:7-8)*

What a marvelous passage that speaks of the great sacrifice that our Lord made on our behalf.

There are about five things mentioned in these two verses that I want to bring to your attention.

Made Himself of no Reputation (v.7). Think about what He had in heaven with the Father and what He gave up to come to this earth and dwell among men. He took upon Him the form of a Servant. John 1:3: *“was the creator of all things.”* Who was in the form of

God but takes on the form of a servant that He might bless the people of the world?

He was made in the likeness of Men. He became flesh and blood so he would be made like unto His brethren. (Hebrews 2:14-17). The Son of Man came to serve not to be served to give His life on a cross for the sins of the world.

On that cross he became obedient unto Death (v.8). He came to do the Father’s will, and the will of the Father was that he become a sacrifice; so that men and women could be saved if they would trust and obey Him.

Why would He suffer such a terrible death? The answer is because he loved His Father and He loved us.

We were not deserving of His death and He did not deserve to die, but He did it for me and you. Here we have the grace of God demonstrated in giving His only begotten Son, as a ransom for us all so that He might bring us to God (Galatians 3:13). Are you willing to surrender your life to Him in obedience to the gospel?
