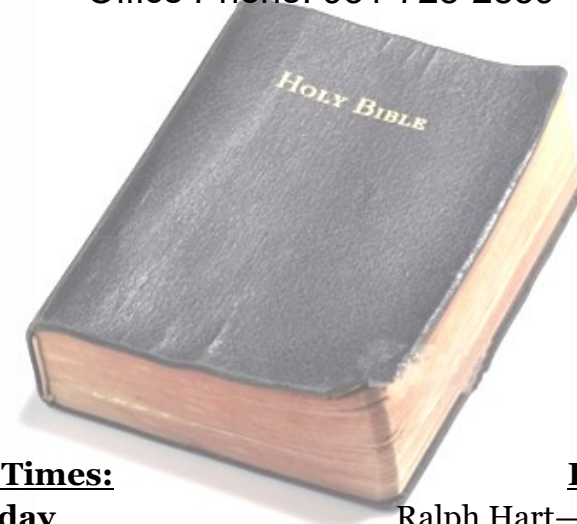

GOD'S CALL

This is made a few times in the Bible when God called certain ones by name. In these cases it was of great urgency that God called them.

I think of the time God called to Samuel.

"And the Lord came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth" (1 Samuel 3:10). You notice that Samuel answered in a positive way. He said: *"Speak; for thy servant heareth."*

Another time was after Moses had fled from Egypt after killing the Egyptian; his brethren rejected him, when two were fighting and he tried to break it up.

Moses saw a burning bush and heard the voice of God calling. *"And when the Lord saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses, And he said, Here am I"* (Exodus 3:4).

In answering this call of God, Moses was to become a leader to bring the people of God out of Egyptian captivity where they had been for over 400 years. In Samuel and Moses case it

was to lead people.

Another one called by God was Abraham.

"And the angel of the Lord called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I" (Genesis 22:11).

This was a time of testing Abraham for the fulfillment of the great promise concerning the blessing of all nations in Genesis 12.

You have Jesus speaking to Peter in Luke. *"And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat"* (Luke 22:31).

He then said to Peter when you art converted, strengthen thy brethren verse 32. Then you have Saul of Tarsus on the road to Damascus and Jesus said to him. "Saul, Saul, why persecutes thou me?" (Acts 9:4). Later to become the great Apostle Paul.

Then last, John giving us the words of our Lord for today.

"And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely" (Revelation 22:17).

"Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Thessalonians 2:14).
