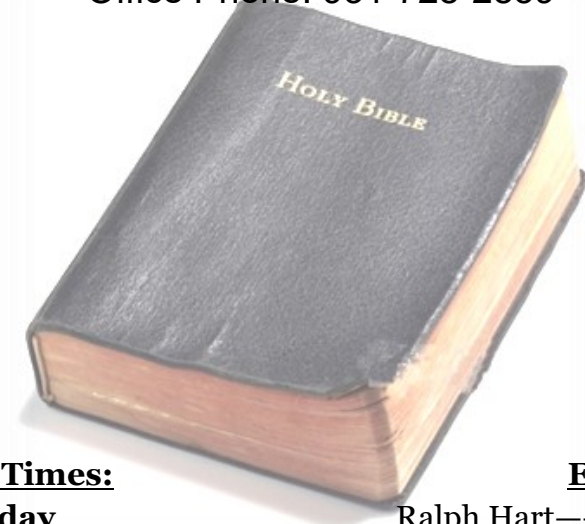

He made new men and women out of hard, selfish ones. It is Christ's spirit and presence alone that will solve the great pressing problems of social inequalities in a peaceful, enduring way.
