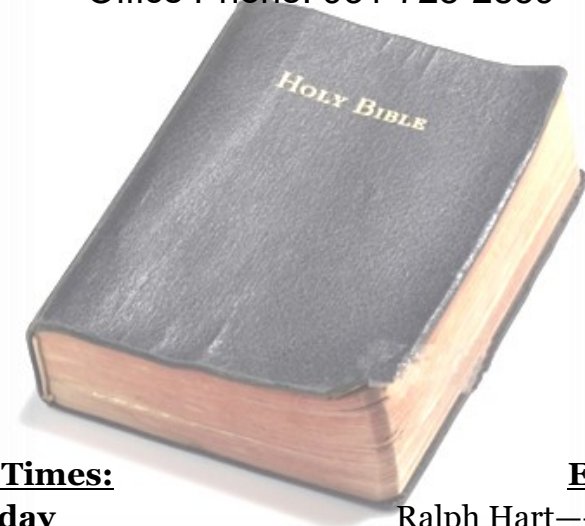

HAPPINESS IS LEARNED, NOT INHERITED

A loving, selfless husband or wife should concentrate on developing his or her disposition. It helps, of course, if you had a happy childhood.

Childhood experiences helps to develop "the habit of happiness." But anybody can develop happiness at any time in life. It is a matter of habit. We can take responsibility for our own behavior.

The love of God can motivate us to develop good habits rather than bad ones. Agape love can help us develop a good disposition. It is a matter of the source of power in our lives.

Who or what controls us? Are we controlled by some frightening irresistible power? Or is our trust in God – to remove the barriers from our wills, to set us free, to give us

control over our lives?

It's "only natural" to take revenge when someone mistreats us. Right? But Jesus said, "love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Matthew 5:44).

He's saying, in effect, "you don't have to let what others do control what you do."

Peter says, "Do not return evil for evil or reviling for reviling; but on the contrary bless, for to this you have been called" (1 Peter 3:9).

A bad disposition is a bad habit that has developed from a loveless base.

But, a disposition that cannot recover quickly from frustration mars all our relationships and leaves behind the torn remains of happy occasions that might have been.

Don't let your past habits control you for the future. Change your ways and have a pleasurable relationship in your marriage.
