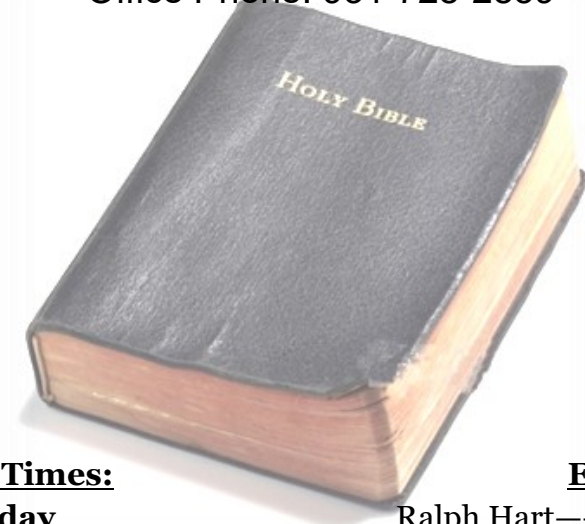

A GOOD EXAMPLE

“Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you” (Philippians 4:9)

In this verse you find the apostle Paul requesting that those at Philippi would follow his example.

Another passage *“Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample”* (Philippians 3:17).

Here again he encourages those to: *“Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ”* (1 Corinthians 11:1).

Paul is not being arrogant in saying such things. Again, to those who were Christians in Corinth: *“Wherefore I beseech you, be ye followers of me”* (1 Corinthians 4:16).

And when he writes to the brethren in Thessalonians he encourages them with these words: *“For yourselves know how ye ought to*

follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you; “Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.” (2 Thessalonians 3:7, 9).

Besides all of these words of encouragement to follow him he considered himself to be the least of the apostles. (1 Corinthians 15:9). In no way was Paul and showoff. He did know that the converts needed an example to see, as well as things to learn.

When it comes right down to it of course our Lord is the perfect example for us to follow, and Paul knew that as well when he said be ye followers of me as I am of Christ. (1 Corinthians 11:1).

Peter instructs us: *“For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps”* (1 Peter 2:21).

Here is something we need to think about. Do people see in us that we are following Christ and setting a pattern for them to follow?
