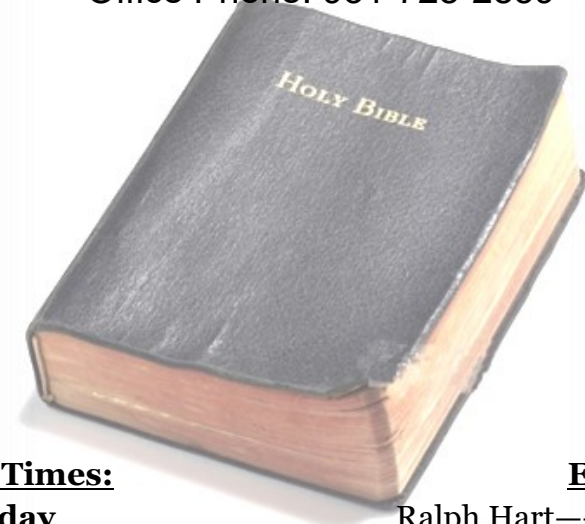

In the book of Psalms there is this scripture: *"I know, O Lord, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me"* (Psalm 119:75)
