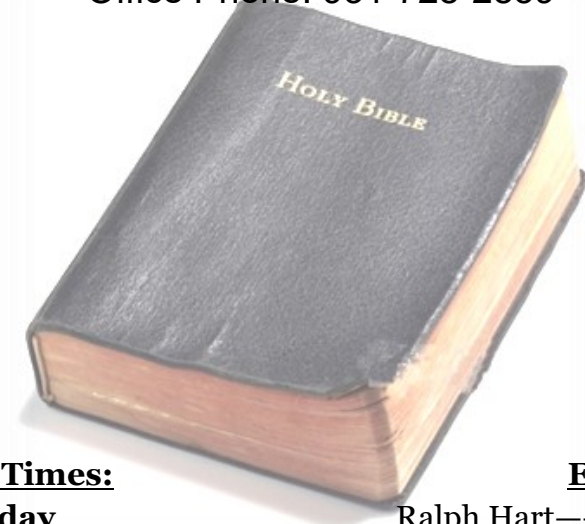

"SHALL NOT'S"

"The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing" (Psalm 34:10).

As you go through the Bible you will find "shall not" used several times. It is used in a way that prohibits certain things.

Things that we are to diametrically oppose in order to have a right relationship with God.

But in other cases it is used in a positive way and is good for us.

Such as Psalms 23 ,where it says, "*The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.*" And in the text where it says, "*but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing.*"

Another place where shall not is used in in John 5:24 "*Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.*"

Jesus also said, this: "*Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life*" (John 8:12).

With this assurance we can have joy with the Psalmist: "*I have set the Lord always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved*" (Psalm 16:8).

"*Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the Lord upholdeth him with his hand*" (Psalm 37:24).

We can rest assured that His words will not pass away, (Matthew 24:35).

And Jesus has promised that "*the gates of Hades will not overpower it.*" referring to the church, of which we are members. (Matthew 16:18).

One other thing, "*Sin shall not have dominion over you*" (Romans 6:14).
