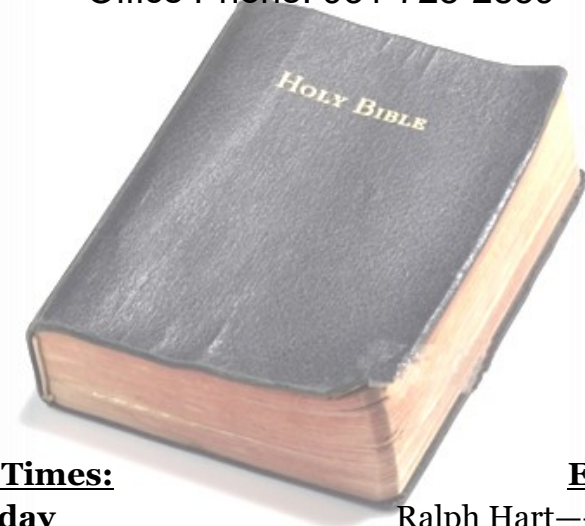

### EPHESIANS EXPERIENCE

#### Ephesians 1:3-13

Here there is a marvelous and comprehensive statement of Divine grace and of the Christians progressive discovery of its riches.

*“Blessed with all spiritual blessings in Christ.”* (v.3). *“Chosen in Him before the foundation of the world”* (v.4). Right on down until the day that *“ye heard the Gospel of your salvation”* (v.13). I want to look at some points found in verse 13, to begin with. Notice that Paul says *“Ye heard the Word of Truth, the Gospel of your salvation.”*

What a Gospel this is! Good news of God’s redeeming love demonstrated in the sacrifice of His Son.

To hear the gospel is to behold an open door into the fullness of blessing found only in Christ. Notice something else in verse 13. *“Ye trusted after that ye heard the word of truth”*.

As we know it is not enough to just hear, there must needs be a commitment of the heart’s affections and confidence.

This trust is the appropriation of the offer God has made through Jesus Christ.

Now back up and see what you have in Christ. You have redemption through His blood (v.7). He gave himself for us that he might redeem us from all iniquity (Titus 2:14).

He is the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Next he says, You have the forgiveness of sins. And that is *“According to the riches of His grace”* (v.7).

How marvelous is His loving-kindness to us, who only deserved righteous condemnation.

He has pulled us out of the miry clay and has washed us clean by the blood of Christ.

We are now the accepted in the beloved (v.6) and we have obtained an inheritance (v.11). *“If children, then heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ; for if we suffer with Him, we may be glorified together”* (Romans 8:17).
