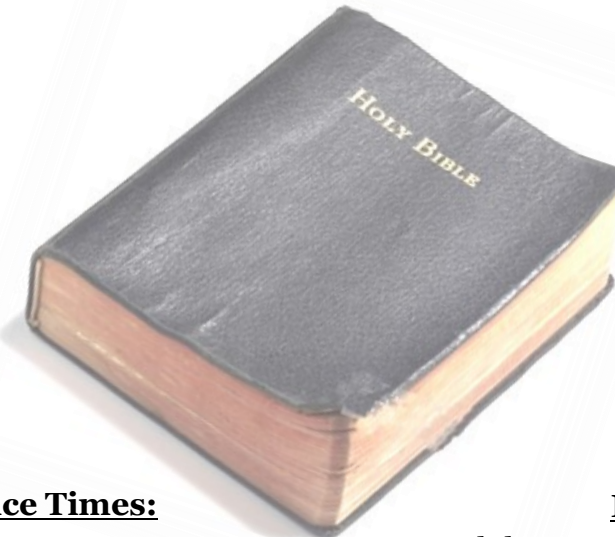

PRAYER AS SUBMISSION

Charles Trumbull, wrote that "prayer is asking God to do what we cannot do."

To pray sincerely denotes complete submission to God. One who prays fervently manifests a spirit of dependence; he is free from an air

of independence and pride. Contritely he implores, "Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer," or he may also plead, "Wash me and I shall be whiter than snow."

A Christian is willing to let God decide whether a request he makes is good for him.

He is willing to be used in the place and in the way the Lord guides. He does not choose his course and then ask God to place his stamp of approval on his actions.

When Jesus prayed he ended his request with "thy will be done." This is our example. The more submissive we are in spirit the more powerful will be our prayers. The Christian life cannot be lived without prayer.

Let us cast our burdens on the Lord. We must pray "according to his will," John wrote, "And this is the confidence that we have in him, if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us."
