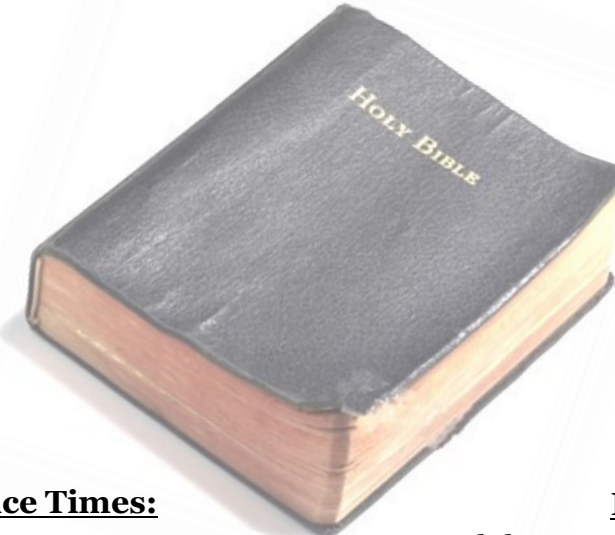

INTERCESSORS

1 TIMOTHY 2:1-6

In Isaiah 59:16 we read that the Lord, “wondered that there was no intercessor.”

This would be a folly and an unbelief of God’s people in abandoning this blessing.

What a privilege intercession is to each child of God. It is a blessing of service that is open an available to every Christian.

Paul indicates the importance of intercession. 1 Tim 2:1 “I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;”

This is a blessing to exercise and it gets first place in his exhortations. Notice

“Moreover as for me, God forbid that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to pray for you: but I will teach you the good and the right way.” (1 Samuel 12:23).

When we do not pray it is not only a sin against our own souls, but our fellowmen, and against God.

Notice that Paul tells us for whom we are to make intercession:

“...for all men; 2, for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.” (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

You notice the results to be accomplished is “that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.”

But there is another reason. 1 Timothy 2:4: “Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth”.

We make intercession for those lost, that they might come to a knowledge of the truth, and obey it in order to be saved.

Let us pray to his end.
