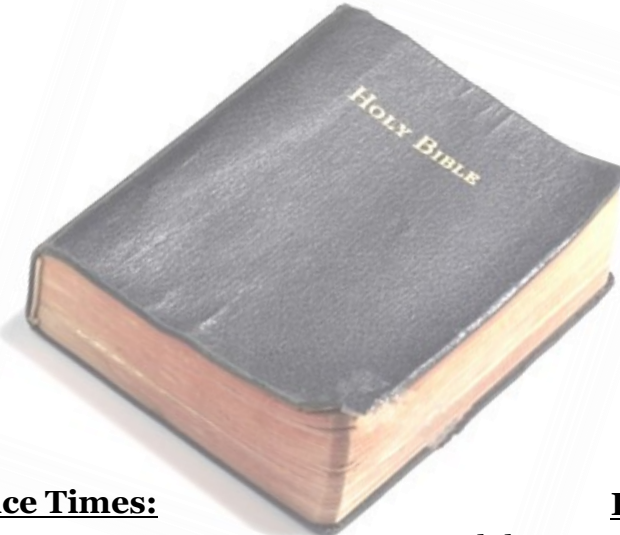

**YES, JESUS CARES!**

LUKE 5:12-16

The man full of leprosy fell on his face before Jesus. A single doubt plagued his mind. The doubt was

not about Jesus' power to heal him. No, countless times Jesus had proven his power to heal broken lives.

Rather, the question in his mind was whether Jesus would want to heal him or not. "Jesus, do you care enough about me to reach out and touch me repulsive sores?"

Not long ago a young college woman came to my office. After nearly an hour of pouring out all the hurt and shame that filled her heart, she asked the leper's question, "Why would Jesus care about me? I'm repulsive!"

When we, like this woman, look at our seemingly insignificant and repulsive lives, we too are tempted to doubt Jesus' concern for us. Then, tragically this doubt too often keeps us from coming to Jesus in prayer.

But it was not so with the man full of leprosy. He simply came to Jesus, doubts and all, saying: "Lord, if you want to you can make me clean." Then Jesus replied, "Yes, I want to."
