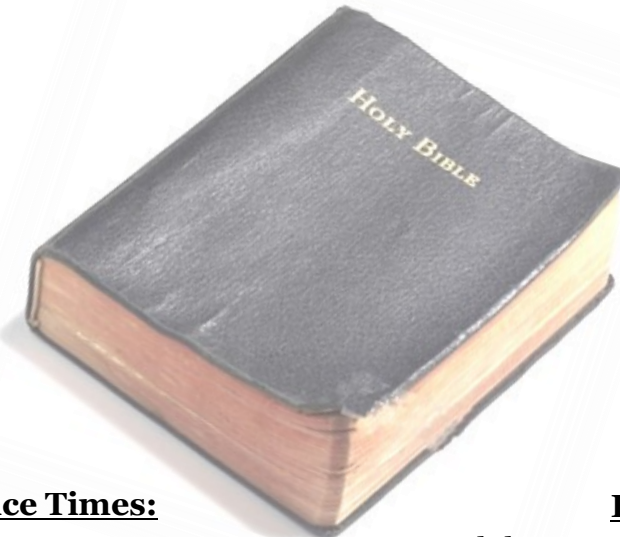

LOVE NOT THE WORLD

Seem like in this present day that people have become so wrapped up in this world, and the things of the world?

The Bible has something to say about that. John recorded these words:

“Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him” (1 John 2:15). This command within itself is enough to warn us of the danger of loving the world.

He tells us why we should not love the world. *“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever”* (1 John 2:16-17).

Things that tempt us and will cause us to be condemned and lost. But you noticed that he that doeth the

will of God abideth forever. According to the Bible the “whole world lies in wickedness” (1 John 5:19).

The apostle Paul warned the Ephesians against *“walking according to the course of this world”* (Ephesians 2:2).

So it is evident that the world does not love Christians. Jesus said to his disciples: *“If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you”* (John 15:19).

As we can see, it is important that we keep ourselves from the things in the world that are evil and sinful. It is unfortunate that Christians leave the faith and go back into the world. Demas is a good example of that.

Here is what Paul said: *“For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia”* (2 Timothy 4:10).
