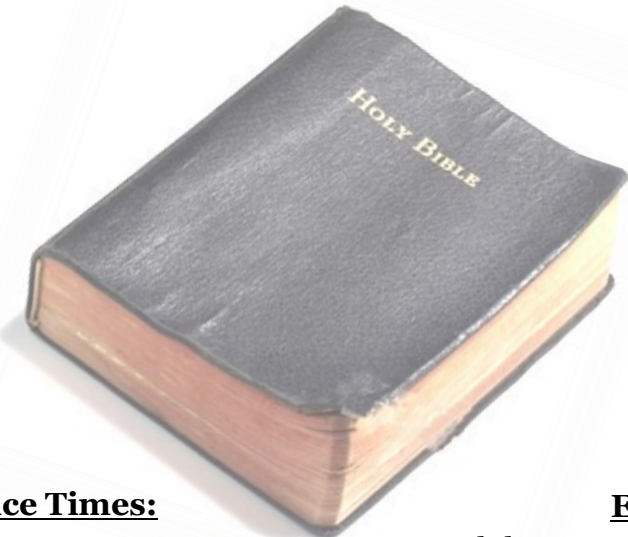

**NEGATIVES TO THE SAVED**

*“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit”* (Romans 8:1).

The little word “no” is extremely important in the spiritual

realm, but perhaps nowhere is it more important than in our text where it provides the basis for our security in Christ. The verdict before salvation was guilty, but after obedience to Christ not guilty. Now there is no condemnation.

But once saved Christians are to obey the following Scriptural commands.

Avoid divisions: *“Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment”* (1 Corinthians 1:10).

Keep your life pure: *“Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed”* (2 Corinthians 6:3).

Keep your speech pure: *“For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips*

*that they speak no guile”* (1 Peter 3:10).

Avoid sin: *“Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates”* (2 Corinthians 13:7).  
Keep from outward display of pride:

*“Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven”* (Matthew 6:1).  
Avoid unholy alliances: *“And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them”* (Ephesians 5:11).

Keep your eyes on Christ: *“And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves”* (Mark 9:8).
