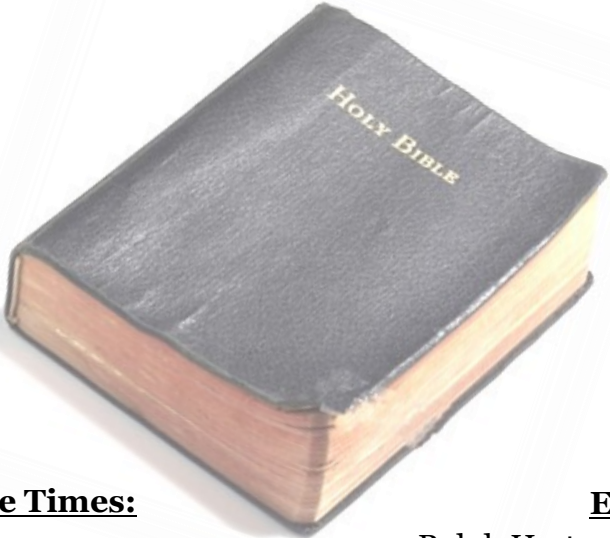

NEAR THE KINGDOM

MARK 12:28-34

The apostle Peter spoke of those people who were “afar off” (Acts 2:39)---the Gentiles, or those people who knew not God, God’s Son, God’s word. In the text, the Savior spoke of a scribe who was near the kingdom.

What kind of a man was he? What were his traits?

He believed in God. Which many people do even today? He believed in the Lord our God, He believed in the oneness of God. The Bible says The Lord is one.” (Acts 17:23).

I think he knew the duty to God. To love him fervently with all the soul. To love him intelligently, with all the mind. To love him energetically, with all thy strength.

He also knew his duty to man. “Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself”. Loving himself, a man will not do himself harm or injury to his body, his character or his good name.

Loving his neighbor as he loves himself, he will do his neighbor no injury, he will work that which is good to his neighbor.

He possessed a proper sense of spiritual values. He did not misplace the emphasis. He placed love to God first.

He placed love to man second. He placed moral and spiritual values above the ritual (Verse 33).

Because he possessed these four traits, Jesus said unto him, “Thou are not far from the kingdom.” Near the kingdom, but not in it. How pathetic to be near the kingdom but not in it, to perish at the door, to be almost persuaded but to fail.

While proper understanding of divine things brings man to the door, obedience is necessary to bring them into the kingdom. (Matthew 7:21, John 3:3-5; Hebrews 5:8-9).

Are you near the kingdom?
