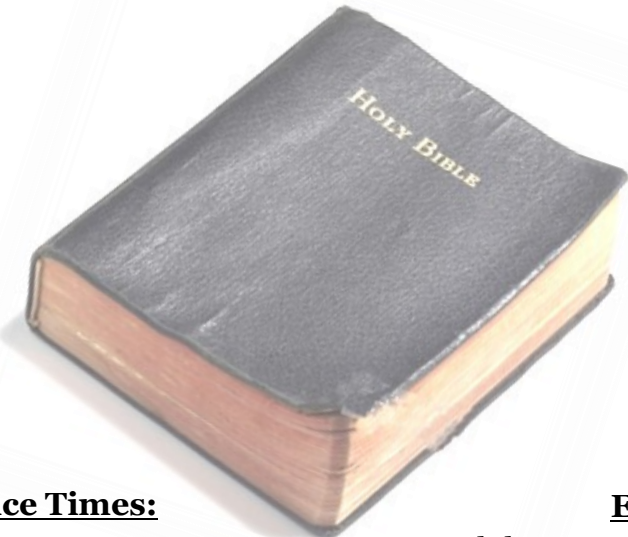

COMPLETE IN CHRIST

Colossians. 2:8-11

“Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. 9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. 10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: 11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:” KJV

The word “spoil” now commonly means corrupt, to cause to decay and perish, as fruit is spoiled by keeping too long, but this is not the meaning of the word as here used.

The Greek word translated makes spoil means to spoil in the sense of plunder, rob,

as when plunder is taken in war.

The meaning is, “Take heed lest anyone plunder or rob you of your faith and hope by his philosophy.”

They were to be evermore on their guard lest false teachers should plunder and rob them of their faith as an invading army would rob a country of all that is valuable.

The warning is very pertinent today. Human reasoning, specious philosophy, is the order of the day; and many are having their faith and hope stolen from them by atheistic and skeptical professors advocating theories antagonistic to the religion of Christ.

If you have Christ you need nothing else, you are complete in Him.
