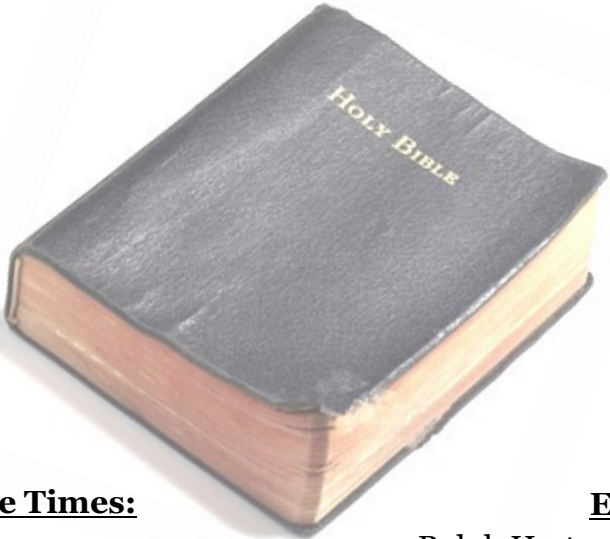

"And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise" (Hebrews 6:15).

Of course, this was Abraham that this inspired statement was made
