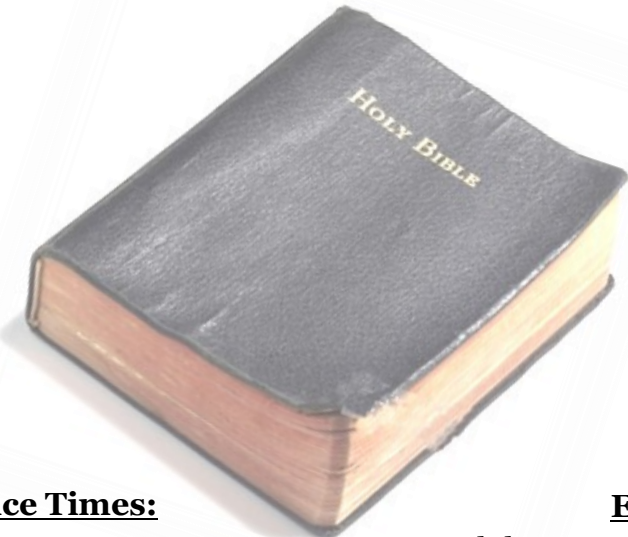

IF YOU ARE HURT BY SOME-ONE

"Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.

17 And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 18:15-19).

Of course, the aim of what Jesus was saying in this passage, to recover the offended party, not to talk to everyone else about it, not to take revenge.

The whole idea is to make reconciliation. If we have love for one another it demands we come to the offender as quickly as we can and not wait for that person to come to us.

When we do then we must come in a loving gentle manner in order to restore souls.

Of course, this section of scripture has been misused to say that this is talking about worship but it is really speaking about one who has been offended coming and doing whatever he or she can to solve the issue.

There is more information involved in the passage. I do believe that if we would practice going to the offended or offender with love and concern most problems would be solved.

If we follow the advice of Jesus, problems can be solved very quickly most of the time.

So, when you have a problem; follow the advice that Jesus gives.
