#### HAVE YOU OBEYED THE

### **GOSPEL?**



God, in His great love, has provided a clear and simple plan for mankind to be saved from sin. The Scriptures teach that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

But through Jesus Christ, God made a way for us to be reconciled to Him. The plan begins with hearing the gospel, for "faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17).

The plan of salvation does not end at baptism. We are called to **live faithfully** unto death (Revelation 2:10), continuing to walk in the light of God's Word (1 John 1:7)

God's plan is not complicated—it is rooted in His grace and revealed in His Word.

The question is whether we will humbly obey it. Have you followed the Lord's plan of salvation?

Paul said, "now is the day of salvation" (2 Corinthians 6:2).
