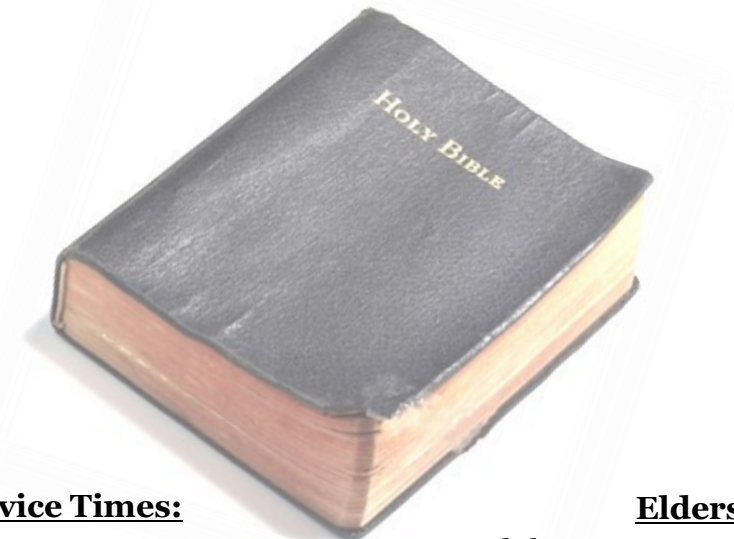

LOOKING AT A PERSON OUTSIDE OF CHRIST

Ephesians 2:1-12

This is the condition of a person before becoming a Christian. Is this how you are? Being out of Christ puts you in a darkness.

You are without life because verse one says you are dead, meaning spiritually dead, in trespasses and sins. You are carnally minded, and that is death.

You are without strength, verse 2. You are one walking according to the course of this world. The world is influencing you to go in the wrong direction. Like a fish out of water, without any power of resistance.

You are without Christ, verse 12. Christ is our future hope, but at this point, he has no existence in one's life. In this state, one's soul

is in poverty, desolation, destitution, affliction, and torment. You are without promise, verse 12. Paul said, you are strangers from the covenant of promise. There are many promises in the Bible, but not one for a man whose mind is at enmity with God. There are exceeding, great, and precious promises. The worldly, carnal, and Christ-less soul sees no value in them.

You are without hope, verse 12. Of course, being without promise, you have no hope. It is a terrible thing to have no hope. He that believeth not is condemned already, without hope.

You are without God in the world, verse 12, where there is so much evidence of God's wisdom, power, and his word that is available to us.

Where we read about His Son coming to this sin- sick world to go the cross and show us how much God loves us. Yet without Christ, you are without God.

I want to tell you that there is no need for you to be in this position. God, through Christ, gives us a plan to follow.
