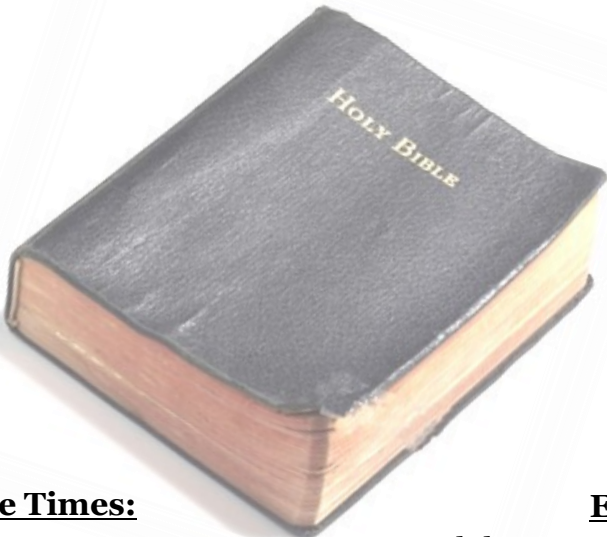

LOOKING AT A PERSON IN CHRIST

EPHESIANS 2:1-13

Last week we looked at a person outside of Christ. So now we look at the person in Christ.

The passage in Ephesians 2, verse one says there is a change that has taken place. Now you are quickened (v 1). You now have a new life where you are alive in Christ, as opposed to being dead in sins. The darkness has passed and now you are in the true light.

You are now made nigh by the blood of Christ (v.13). You believed, trusted in Christ, and obeyed His will. Now, where you were separated from Christ, you have fellowship with God. You have been reconciled to God by Christ.
