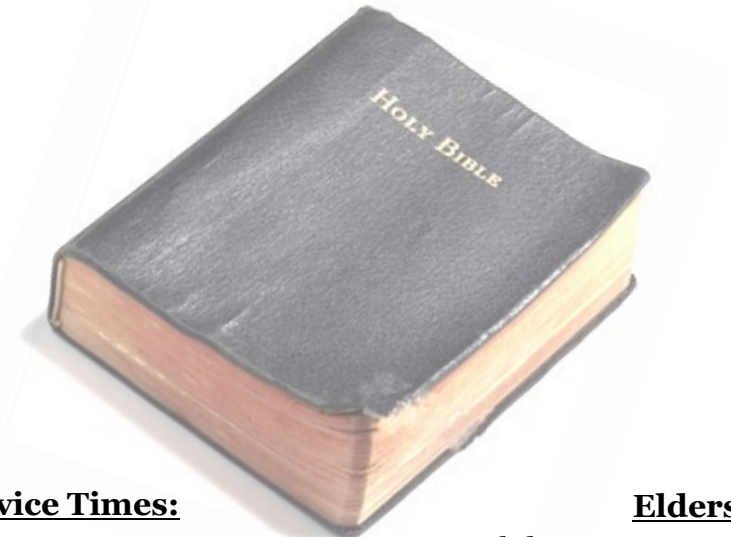

HOLY LIVING

"But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:15-16).

Some time ago when we studied the book of Leviticus, in chapter 19 God speaks of being holy. Above is a quotation by Peter from this chapter. A holy life is the most useful of all lives, the holy person is the most practical of all. There are some ideas or characteristics of a holy life.

According to Leviticus 19, a holy person is one who will honor his father and mother, you find that in verse three. This is such a needed thing for children in our world today. "Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the

land which the Lord thy God giveth thee" (Exodus 20:12).

Then in verse four, a holy person has nothing to do with idols. In other words nothing is allowed to take the place of God in your affections and life. A holy person seeks to please God and only God and flees from Idolatry. "Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry" (1 Corinthians 10:14).

Also you notice in verse 5, that the holy person will sacrifice. Of course it was different then than now, but we still need to make sacrifice to the Lord. We need to be delighted to come to worship and praise Him. Even when it may be a little difficult. Think of the sacrifice that Jesus made for us in going to the cross.

One more thing I want us to think about is found in verse 12. A holy person will not dishonor the name of God. In our society today there is so much of using the name of God in vain. You hear this out in public, on TV, and just about everywhere.

His name is holy and we need to understand that. We should never tarnish the name of our Lord. There is much more that could be said but think about living a holy life so to be an example to all.
