As an augment of our Christmas holiday message, we would like to add a few more details of the work conducted over the past several months. In this past year, we have traveled to 14 supporting congregations across the country, sharing in worship and in fellowship. My goal for the most part is to visit all or as many contributing congregations as I can within a two-year cycle, ensuring that you are getting a firsthand report of the work that you support. Renee will be returning with me on the upcoming visit to India in 2026, her first visit back since 2013. In recent years she has stayed to care for her mother, who passed away in October of this year. God willing, the good sisters and the children will welcome her return.

Back in India:

In Pamidipadu, brother Mark Palaparthi continues to preach in large areas of farmlands and villages in southeaster part of the country. Brother Mark preaches at two different locations on the Lord's day and is routinely invited to many group gospel meetings in the area.

In Bagdogra, brother Joseph Kahti continues to preach in local villages in Bagdogra, and in far inland villages of Nepal. As part of his outreach, brother Joseph preached in Diwali, one of the largest Hindu festivals in Nepal, preaching to over 150 people.

In Bhopal, brother Boaz Songa preaches in that area in two different local languages for adult worship, and along with his sister Pallavi, children's classes as well. He goes out several times a week to teach at night meetings in areas near him.

In Hyderabad, brother Y. John Wilson preaches and teaches in four districts in a highly populated area yielding several baptisms. In a large city like Hyderabad, brother John also presides over many weddings, and many funerals.

In Thimmapuram, brother Babu Rao preaches and teaches in the local communities on a wide range of topics, including a couples class that will begin this month. He also attends bible classes in various preaching schools, where he both learns as a student, and teaches as a preacher of the gospel.

From year to year, and every season, God's word continues to be preached in all the world!

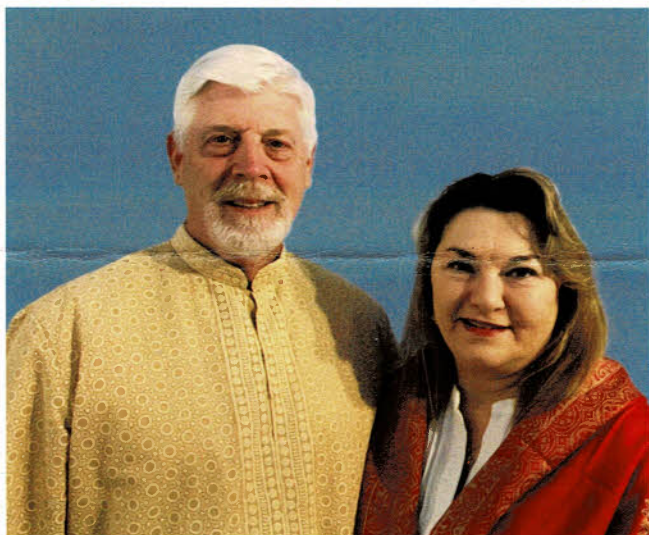
To our dear brothers and sisters in Christ, greetings from the Manassas church of Christ India Mission Team! As the holidays approach, we wanted to make sure you know that you are in our prayers, praying that your holidays are safe and that your families are blessed. We also want to continue to keep you informed of the work that is being conducted across the Indian subcontinent, and here at home. We have been blessed with enough funding this year to build new village churches, adding a new dormitory to one of schools of preaching, and providing much needed maintenance for various church locations.

The monsoons and rainy season this time of year always do damage to so many. Homes are damaged, destroyed or lost. Many lives are taken in the floods, and many more go homeless and without food for days before relief comes. Your support provides relief for those brethren, for food and essentials for their homes. When in those situations they are not allowed to stay in the area, we can help them move to friends and family in dryer locations. Despite all this the work continues. Our teachers and preachers may have to hunker down for a few days, but the schools continue, and the preaching and teaching continue. We have two schools that have started up again in southeastern Pamidipadu, and up on the northern border in Bagdogra. We are developing new curriculums for schools in Bhopal and Kurnool, and continue the work in other supported areas such as Gannavaram, Thimmapuram, Kadavakuduru, Bidar, Hyderabad, Bhadravati and many more.

Please continue to pray for the work, for our travels, and for the brethren in India, that the work of the Lord will continue to seek and save the lost.
