LEPROSY A DEPLORABLE SIGHT

Luke 17:11-19

There were times that Jesus demonstrated His power to cleanse the terrible disease of leprosy. This demonstrates the compassion that Jesus had for those who suffered and there was no physician to help cure.

In Luke 17, ten men met Jesus and all were men who had leprosy. Leprosy is like sin in a person's life. It is something that will destroy a person unless, the sin can be removed and they are cleansed.

In the case of sin, it takes the blood of Jesus to take care of the sin problem. And just like leprosy, the only person that could take care of leprosy was the Lord.

Leprosy is uncleanness. A leper would have to cry out with his mouth covered "Unclean, unclean" according to Leviticus 13:45. Leprosy was also something that separated people, they stood afar off (Luke 17:12). Not only that but he dwelled outside the camp (Leviticus 13:46). Far off are those who have not been cleansed by the blood of Jesus (Ephesians 2:13).

Like leprosy, sin is humanly incurable. Man has no remedy for leprosy and neither for sin. Both bring death to the individual. But there is a remedy for both and the remedy in found in obeying the plan of Jesus.

In Luke 17:14, Jesus told the lepers to go show themselves to the priests. In the case of sin, we must obey the commands of the Lord which are belief, repentance, confession and then being baptized in order for our sins to be removed and we are cleansed.

It is all accomplished because of the shedding of Jesus blood on the cross.

Why stay a sinner when you can be so easily cleansed?
